

What are the Benefits of Participating in the EAGeR Study???

As a participant in the EAGeR Study, you will receive:

- Supplemental medical surveillance while you are trying to conceive, as well as throughout your pregnancy if you do conceive while in the study.
- A fertility monitor, which will allow you visualize your fertile period and help you to determine the best time to try to conceive.
- Pregnancy tests provided by the study.
- Study provided folic acid pills.
- An additional ultrasound at 6.5 weeks of pregnancy.
- Compensation of ten (10) dollars (if you live in Lackawanna County) or fifteen (15) dollars (if you live in Luzerne or Wayne counties) for each study visit that you have.
- Education by registered nurses.
- Quarterly newsletters, which include articles relating to trying to conceive and pregnancy, a question/answer corner for any questions that arise by participants in the study, and updated information about what is happening in the study.

The most intensive phase of the protocol only requires about 10-15 minutes of your time daily!

There is no known risk of taking 81mg aspirin (baby aspirin) to you or your child.
